Ford to Save Façade

Ford Motor Company has agreed to preserve part of the façade of its former assembly plant in Highland Park in hopes that it will be incorporated in a future development at the site. The façade that will be saved is a portion of the north and west sides of the original showroom at the northwest corner of the Ford Plant. The whole showroom will not be saved and that disappointed local historians and car enthusiasts.

The showroom is one of the few remaining sections of the original 1920s assembly plant. The showroom features that will be saved include 5 bays on the west façade and the fluted columns between them, two bays on the north façade and the columns between them, all of the medallions and light fixtures on the two façades, the red clay roof tiles above the façades and the decorative frieze on the west side of the building.

A local preservation firm has been hired to remove and store the architectural elements, though how they will be reused will depend on the new developer or developers and probably will not be known for several years.
