"Liar, Liar, pants on fire. Your nose is longer than a telephone wire. You ask me baby, why I'm sad. Been out all night, I know you've been bad. Don't tell me different I know that you lied. Come to me, honey, and see how I've cried."

The Castaways are a nationally-known Minnesota-based Rock 'n' Roll band that audiences have been demanding, and enjoying, for many years. Jim Donna, keyboards and vocals, was one of the original founders of the band. In the band's early days, The Castaways recorded "Liar, Liar", co-written by Jim Donna. The release of their Soma Record hit the Billboard charts in 1965, going number 1 regionally, and as high as #9 coast to coast. The song stayed on the top 100 charts for 33 weeks.



By the end of 1965, The Castaways had sold nearly 1 million copies of their infectious Soma smash single "Liar, Liar" and were literally "On Fire". They were on a West Coast tour that had them appearing on "Hollywood A Go Go", "Shivaree", "Where The Action Is", and various other Dick Clark productions. It was also at this time that they had a cameo appearance in the Hollywood movie "It's a Bikini World" where they performed along with Eric Burdon and the Animals, The Toys, The Gentry's, Tommy Kirk and Deborah Walley.

The Castaways were booking tour dates with Sonny and Cher, The Beach Boys, The Everly Brothers, The Byrds, Glen Campbell, Little Anthony and the Imperials, The Loving Spoonful, Herman's Hermits, Brian Highland, the Mama's and Papas and many more groups. They did two West Coast tours during 1965-1966.

The song "Liar, Liar" has been used in 3 movies to date including "It's a Bikini World" "Good Morning Vietnam" and "Lock, Stock and 3 Smoking Barrels."

In later years, Bob Donna, guitar and vocals, joined the band, along with Rick Snider on drums and vocals, and Ralph Hintz, bass and vocals. Jim Donna has been inducted into the Minnesota Rock/Country Hall of Fame, the South Dakota Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and the Iowa Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.
