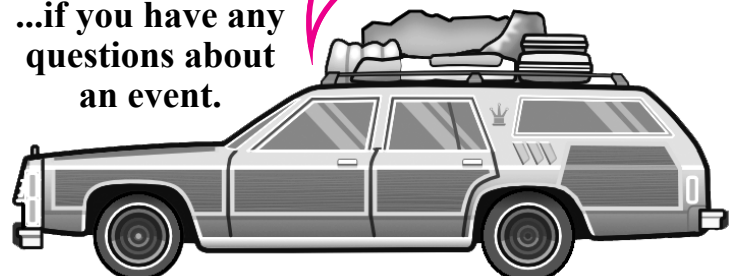

DID YOU KNOW... That there actually are 2 harbors with a walking trail connecting them? You can view the historic Edna G tugboat and ore boats being loaded with taconite pellets at the westerly end of the trail in Paul Van Hoven Park, walk along the trail fronting Agate Bay and stroll along the breakwater stretching nearly 1/3 mile out into Lake Superior. It's not uncommon to see some nice catches of Lake Trout, Herring or Coho Salmon directly from the breakwater, so bring your fishing license and your pole. Bait is available locally. The trail meanders around Lighthouse Point with scenic ledge rock along the water's edge, an abandoned stone quarry, low cliffs and sand and pebble beaches along the way.
