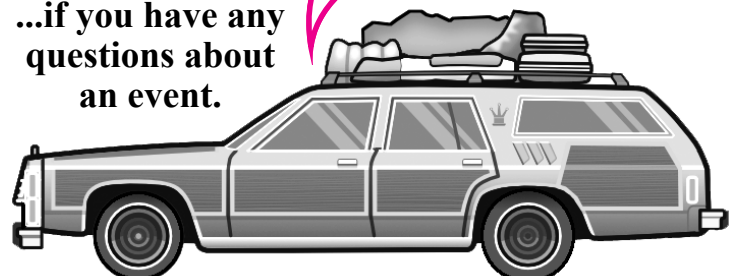

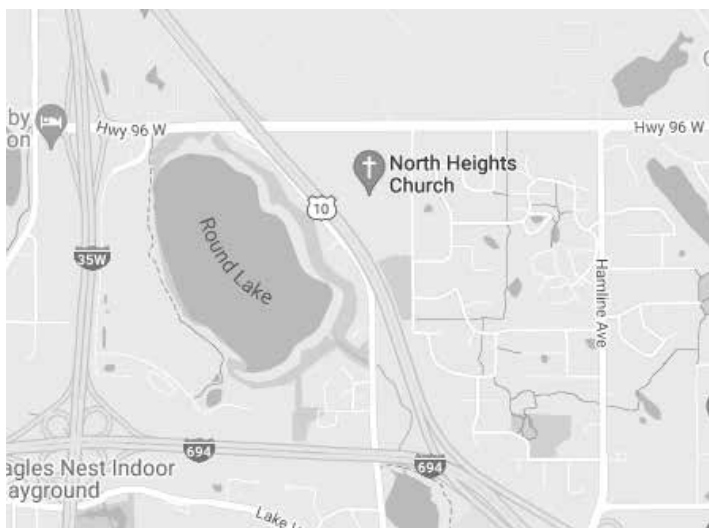

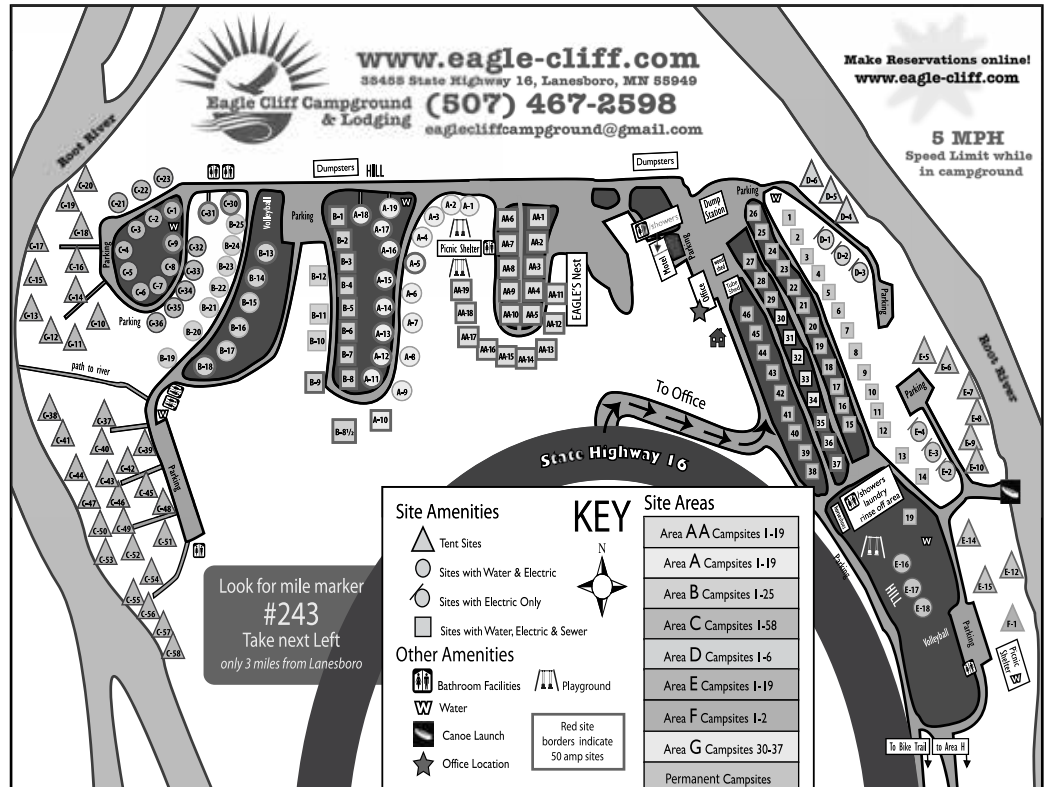

News From The Outstate

As you read this, there will be only one indoor show left where I'll have an MSRA display. I'm looking forward to getting back to Grand Forks to see and be a part of the Prime Steel Show. I'm sure there will be a fine display of very nice vehicles.

What I'm really interested in highlighting this month is the Run to the Hill. This event will be held on May 7th, and the focus is on our members lobbying our personal senators and representatives in the Minnesota Legislature to make our presence known to them. This is our opportunity to let them know our concerns about legislation that may affect our hobby/way of life.

These days you don't have to go too far to hear disparaging remarks about our politicians and the job they are doing. It doesn't matter what "side" you are on, there is a lot of complaining (to use a sanitized word here) about the laws and regulations being discussed. Now is your chance. Make

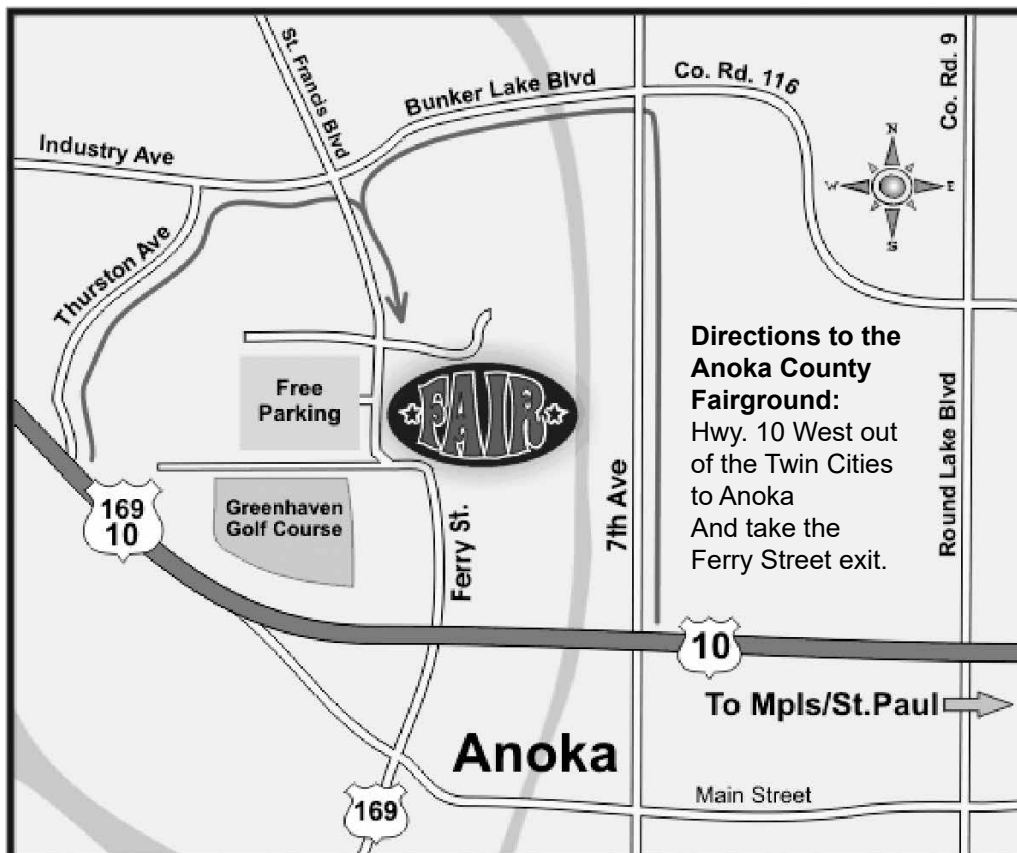

DID YOU KNOW... That the 3M Company began in 1902 in Two Harbors, Minnesota? Originally the company, then named Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing, was involved in mining for corundum, a mineral deposit for grinding wheel abrasives. As you all know, they have since moved on, but the site of the original company is one of several museums in Two Harbors and is located at the corner of 2nd Avenue & Waterfront Drive.



Other museums include the Duluth & Iron Range Railroad Depot which was in operation until 1961. The Depot Museum is located on South Avenue overlooking the waterfront and ore docks where ore boats load taconite pellets to be shipped down the Great Lakes for steelmaking. Its 4,000 square feet of indoor exhibit space and outdoor train exhibits detail the history of Two Harbors.

The Lake County Historical Society began to provide tours of the Light Station in 1988 when it was granted a lease by the US Coast Guard. In 1999, the Society appealed to Congressman Oberstar and through a bill passed in congress, the ownership of the Two Harbors Lighthouse was transferred to the Lake County Historical Society. The Lighthouse Bed & Breakfast opened in 1999 to provide support for the preservation of the buildings and grounds. The Society assumed responsibility for the light maintenance and operation from the US Coast Guard in 2001. The light has been maintained with the help from volunteer lighthouse keepers for the past twenty years and remains a private aid to navigation. Lighthouse Point at the base of the breakwater is the site of the third museum that you may want to visit while you're in Two Harbors.
