## Friday Nights in North St. Paul

Since it was announced that the North St. Paul History Cruze would change this year from every Friday night to every other Friday night, we have received many calls asking WHY?. I will try to answer this and hopefully not get too long winded. You may want to read to the end because this applies not only to the History Cruze, but to many other car shows as well.

We are all getting older! Some of us would like to have a week off once in a while instead of working the show fifteen weeks in a row. For this reason, we have asked for volunteers for the last several years, and once in a while we get a new volunteer and they last a week or two and then quit because they don't want to be yelled at, swore at, or ignored - so we have a problem keeping them. It takes a couple of times working the gates to get to know what to expect and how to "handle" the crowd. We don't expect a new recruit to be on their own the first time. So, if you have thick enough skin to not get upset by getting yelled at, we would love to have you join us. If we have enough people, we could schedule crews for weeks on and weeks off, or for shifts each week so you don't have to work the whole night and possibly go back to having the show every week again. (With regard to handling the crowd: Has anyone else noted that since COVID people in general have gotten more individual oriented and nasty instead of community oriented and have displayed more aggressive driving habits?)

The volunteers that work the gates and circulate through the show are just that – VOLUNTEERS! None of the staff get paid for what they do. The History Cruze is a non-profit LLC, and as such can only keep a limited amount of money in an account to cover expenses and get the show started the following year. Many people think the show is put on by the city of North St. Paul, but it is not. We pay a permit fee to the

city to have the show each year, as well as the operational costs for the show including insurance, police coverage, Porta Potties, etc. (all required by the city) and other incidentals such as signs, barricades, etc. At the end of the year, any extra funds are donated to local charities. We do not collect admission from either participants or spectators because it would be nearly impossible without fencing in the city, we rely completely on sponsors and vendor fees to financially support the show.

With regard to crowd control: In the past (pre-COVID) if there was a discipline problem with either a rowdy participant or spectator nearby, participants would rally around a volunteer until the offender would back down. This has not been the case lately, but rather they side with the offender and start yelling at our volunteers. We are only trying to enforce the rules – some of them mandated by the city and some just in common sense. How about a little support? BY THE WAY: Did you know that it is against state law to move or drive around a barricade? I had people yell at me when I tried to point that out to someone who had just done that. Last year we also had two drivers push (with their cars) our volunteers after they were told they could not proceed. For this reason, we are going to place cameras at each corner to monitor the intersection. In case of another incident such as this, the video can be submitted as evidence.

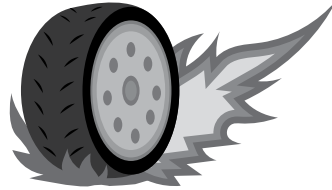
We want everyone who attends the show to have fun – both the participants and the spectators. Many people tell us they come just to walk around, get some good unhealthy food, and look at the cars. Many spectators bring their kids – we want this to be good family friendly entertainment. The rules were established for this to be the case, not because we just decided to be nasty. You are not above the rules just because you have the "best car here".

# MSRA FALL CAMPOUT

I've been working with the fine folks in the Vintiques Car Club in Watertown, South Dakota for about two years to get things underway for the 2026 MSRA Fall Campout. I'm excited to be able to bring the campout to a new area where members can check out what the 47th Annual Vintiques Rod Run and Campout is all about. The campout will be happening the weekend of September 11-13, 2026.

The Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park is where MSRA will have campsites reserved for us. For campsites, check the picture below and send in a note and a check for your site reservation to the Vintiques Car Club, PO Box 135, Watertown, SD 57201. All members who plan to attend will also need to send in reservation money to secure your spot for the event. To reserve your event spot, Google 'Vintiques 47th Rod Run and Campout', print a copy of the form, fill it out and send a check for \$40 to the same address listed above. When you show up at the event, your registration check will be returned to you. If you do not show up, your registration will not be returned to you. Also note that if you will be camping, send in two checks – one for your campsite, and another for the event registration. MSRA will pay for Friday and Saturday night camping at the Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park; if you camp any other nights, the cost is on you.

Here is important information regarding camp spots. There are 63 regular camp sites, and there are 5 that are "pull through". The "pull through" sites are \$97 for Friday and Saturday. The regular sites are \$67 for the weekend. When you send money to reserve your site, send one check for the campsite, and one for \$40 to the Vintiques at the address listed above. Make the checks out to the Vintiques Car Club. You can reserve your particular site by calling Kevin Gribble at 605-881-1734.

If you will be staying in a motel, a list of a dozen local motels can be found on the registration form. Also, the registration form has detailed information about the activities that will be happening throughout the weekend. I know I'm looking forward to this event. I hope you are too.

**UPDATE:** As of May 5th, there were about 14 camp spots left for the MSRA group. This tells me that there will be a good turnout at the MSRA Fall Campout. I've heard from many people that they have never been able to attend a campout because it was always so far away, and they are happy to be able to participate. I know Watertown will roll out the red carpet for our fun vehicles.

Believe it or not, there have been members taking advantage of how policies have been in the past. It was always, "Don't worry, we'll have you covered. Just show up". Everything is more expensive now, and folks putting on the campout need to know concrete numbers for planning meals and camping. MSRA will pay for Friday and Saturday night camping at the park. MSRA will pay for a vehicle entry to their weekend, which includes meals. But you need to reserve your spot by sending a check for the event, and if you're camping, send a check for the deposit for your site. Think of it as just saving your spot. You will get your check back when you check in at the event. If you don't show up, your check will not be returned.

If you are staying in a motel, make sure you get your reservations made. The hotels can fill up quickly. Also, get your event reservation in by August 15th. Check out paragraphs 2 and 3 above and all of the information is there on what to do to reserve a spot.
