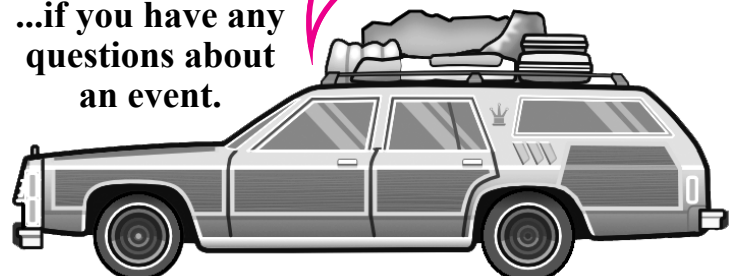

Super Secret Fun Run

Join us for the 21st edition of the MSRA Super Secret Fun Run on August 28-30, 2026. Once again, the event will be held at Brainerd International Raceway in Brainerd, MN. The rules have been pretty much unchanged since the inception of this event. **This event is for current MSRA members only; please bring your current membership card. On-track activities are open to 1995 and older vehicles ONLY.** If you own a later model car (1996 or newer) and you want to bring it to Brainerd, you are welcome to do so but you cannot participate in any of the on-track activities.

The Super Secret Fun Run is an MSRA Voting Event this year. The Voting Event will take place in the area between the condos and the main grandstand (on the south side of the drag strip). The Voting Event will be from 11:00am – 1:00pm on Saturday August 29th.

As in the past, drag racing will take place all day on both Saturday and Sunday, weather permitting. MSRA members will be allowed to make passes down the drag strip provided their cars pass the on-site NHRA Tech & Safety Inspection conducted by the staff of BIR. Your vehicle must have the minimum required safety equipment for the speed and ET your vehicle runs in order to make a pass down the drag strip. Some examples of missed items from previous years are: missing or improperly installed seat belts, missing or leaking coolant overflow tank, missing or broken battery hold down, nylon tubing used for mechanical oil pressure gauges and missing or expired helmet. **Helmets are required for all racers. Helmets must be rated SNELL 2015 or newer.**

All drivers must have a valid driver's license and must be at least 16 years old to race. Drivers who are 16 and 17 years old must have a waiver (Minor Release) signed at the front gate by parent(s) and must be accompanied by a parent. Full length pants, short or long-sleeved shirt and closed shoes and socks are required for all drivers and passengers. Drivers or passengers cannot wear shorts, nylon wind pants, tank tops, or muscle shirts. No bare legs or bare torsos permitted while racing. No open toe, open heel or sandals allowed. Cars cannot run faster than 14.00 seconds in the quarter mile with a passenger. All passengers must be 18 years or older. If you do not pass Tech, you do not get to run your car.

Camping is handled by the staff at BIR. You can call them to reserve a campsite at 218-824-7223 or 866-444-4455. **Please call the staff at BIR for current camping prices.** If camping is not your style, you can also rent one of their condos or stay at one of the many hotels in the Brainerd Lakes area.

All non-licensed motorized vehicles (any vehicle that does not have current state roadworthy licensing) will require an authorization sticker to operate on BIR grounds. The authorization stickers will be available for sale at the front gate during the event. To purchase a non-licensed vehicle ticket, an adult (over 18 years old) with a valid driver's license must sign a release waiver and take full responsibility for that vehicle and any and all injuries/damages it causes. For more track info visit their website www.birmn.com.

MSRA will NOT be providing food on Friday and Saturday evenings this year. There will be food available for purchase at the track and in the area surrounding the track.

Local noise ordinances prohibit the starting of any unmuffled vehicles or loud music between the hours of 9:00pm - 9:00am (no generators between the hours of 11:00pm – 7:00am). **Also, FIREWORKS ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Failure to adhere to these simple rules will result in members being removed from the event and not allowed to attend in the future. All decisions of the MSRA Board of Directors and the staff at BIR are final.

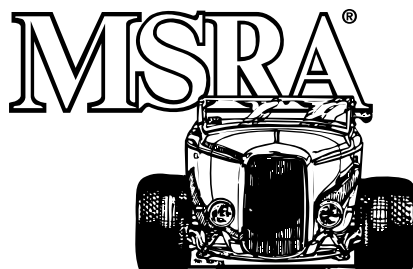

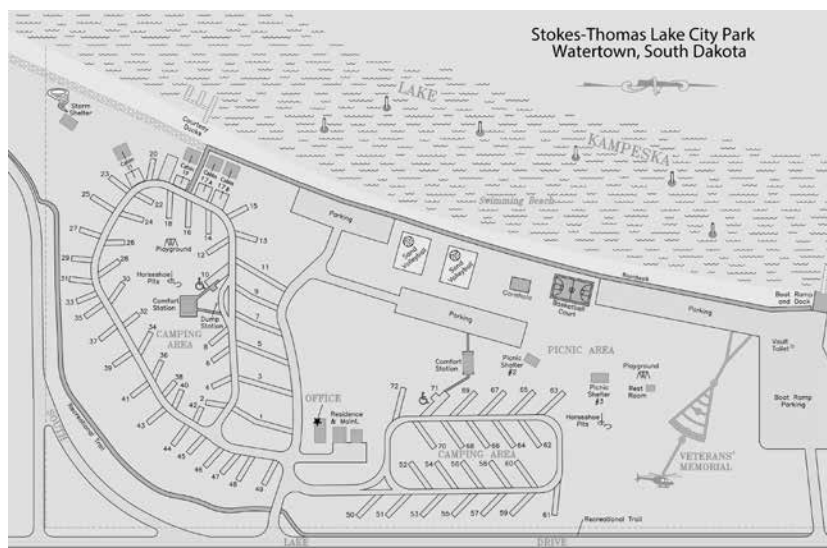

Everything is more expensive now, and folks putting on the campout need to know concrete numbers for planning meals and camping. MSRA will pay for Friday and Saturday night camping at the park. MSRA will pay for a vehicle entry to their weekend, which includes meals. But you need to reserve your spot by sending a check for the event, and if you're camping, send a check for the deposit for your site. Think of it as just saving your spot. You will get your check back when you check in at the event. If you don't show up, your check will not be returned.

If you are staying in a motel, make sure you get your reservations made. The hotels can fill up quickly. Also, **get your event reservation in by August 15th**. Check out paragraphs 2 and 3 above and all of the information is there on what to do to reserve a spot.
